Beginner Ladies' Program

This program is geared for all women interested in taking up the game or who have just started playing. Every Tuesday at 3:00 P.M., instructors will conduct a one hour clinic. The topics each week will include short game fundamentals such as putting, chipping and pitching; rules and etiquette; and full swing Fundamentals. Ladies will then pair into groups and play golf using a scramble format. Intermediate Ladies' Program



This program is geared for all women who have been playing for more than 1 year. Every Friday from January 15th to March 26th at 2:00 P.M., instructors will conduct a one hour clinic. The topics each week will include short game fundamentals such as putting, chipping and pitching; rules and etiquette; and full swing Fundamentals. Ladies will then pair into groups and play golf using a scramble format. Teaching Philosophy

Both Bob and Bela's objective as instructors of the game of golf is to take your golf swing and make it work effectively. We try to make minimal changes and work on the fundamentals of the swing. When you finish each session, the improvement will be noticeable and easy to practice. We guarantee each lesson will be a positive experience.

Golf is one of the few games where you cannot teach yourself. If you practice bad habits, you will become a frustrated golfer. It is best to have a trained pair of eyes by qualified, trained PGA Professionals to help you develop good practice and swing habits.

Do you know that on average, Putting consists of 43% of the score, Chipping 13% and Pitching (Shots from within 40 yards of the green) another 8%. Why is it then, most average golfers if and when they do practice, head to the driving range and immediately take out the driver?

Remember, amateurs teach amateurs to play like amateurs.

Bob Komarinetz, the Director of Golf at Sandridge Golf Club, is a thirty-eight year member of the PGA of America. Bob was the 1982 recipient of the South Florida Section PGA Golf Professional of the Year. He also received the 1992 Junior Golf Leader award from the Southeast Chapter of the South Florida Section PGA and the 1993 Junior Golf Leader award from the South Florida Section PGA.
