

## 2017/18 County Card/USGA Handicap System Renewals

The 2017-2018 Sandridge County Cards will be sold beginning October 1, 2017. Sandridge Card Holders receive a reduced rate for greens fees (as much as \$10.00 in the winter), eight day advance tee times, and a reduced rate for the Handicap System.

This year in order to be eligible to purchase a Sandridge County Card, you must have one of the following proofs of residency: (1) Valid Florida driver's license with an Indian River County address; (2) Indian River County Registration Card ; or (3) Property Tax Bill/Receipt. The cost to renew or purchase a Sandridge Card will be \$40.00 plus tax for Indian River County Residents. **Utility bills are not accepted.**

We also offer a Florida Card for \$60.00 plus tax or Florida residents. Florida Card holders will receive the same rate and six day advance reservations. To be eligible to purchase a Florida Card, you must meet one of the three criteria mentioned above with a Florida address.

This year, you can renew your County Cards online at [www.golfsandridge.com](http://www.golfsandridge.com). This feature will only be for renewals only and not for new County Cards.

Also, beginning on October 1st, the USGA Ghin Handicap system Fees are due. The fee covers the GHIN Handicap from October 1st to September 30th and this year again, the fee will be \$20.00 + tax for Sandridge I.D. Cardholders and \$25.00 + tax for Non-Cardholders.

Local players wanting to play competitively are playing every week at the Sandridge Golf Club Thursday and Saturday Blitz. The Blitz begins at 8:00 A.M. every Saturday (18 holes) and alternates courses every week.

All players play an individual Stableford format, point quota system. A bogey is worth one point, par – two points, birdie – four points, eagle – eight points, and a double eagle or hole in one is worth sixteen points.

Players must sign up by Thursday at 6:00 P.M. in order to play in the Saturday blitz. The cost per player is \$60.00 for the 18 hole Saturday Blitz through April 8th and \$50.00 per player from April 15th to 29th. ### Sunday Couples League

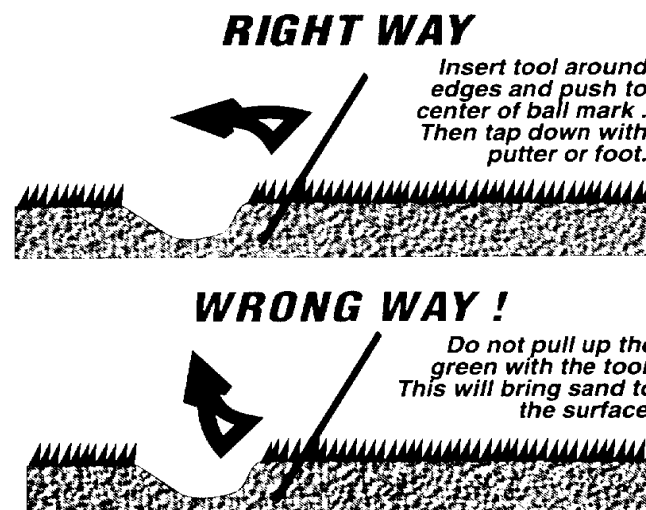
The Sandridge Golf Club Couples' League plays every Sunday afternoon. Every week, the group starts at the same time with a 2:30 PM Shotgun Start. The format is a two person scramble with a points quota format. For instance, for a bogey you get 1 point, par 2 points, birdie 4 points, eagle 6 points. The first time you play, you are qualifying to see how many points you make and then after the first round, you play to your quota and it is adjusted based on how many points you make that day.

The cost each week to play starting through October is \$40.00 per couple which will include a range token, 9 holes with a cart and prizes. The price will go up to \$50.00 in November for the winter and there is no fee to join the league!

**90° RULE:** When carts are permitted on fairways, stay on cart path or, when no path available, in deep rough. When opposite your ball, drive straight to it. After hitting ball, return to path or deep rough.
