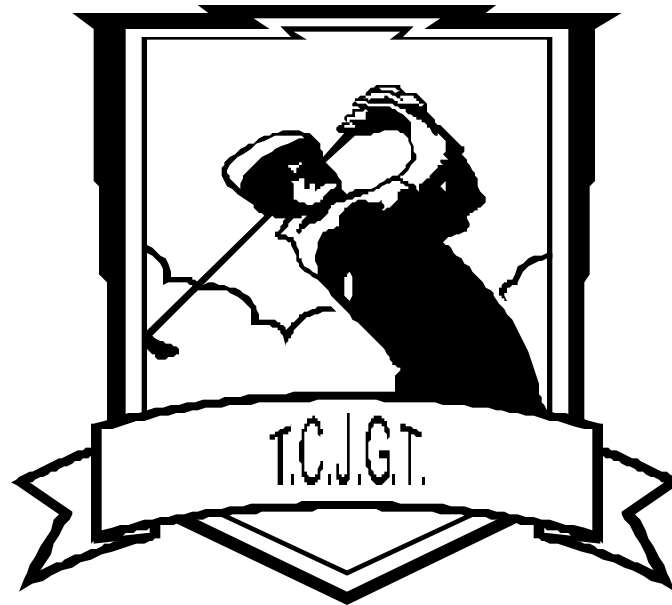

## Tournament Information

**Mission Statement:** The goal of the Treasure Coast Junior Golf Tour is to provide a positive, competitive environment that enables young golfers to improve their skill levels and become better individuals. The Tour not only challenges junior players to excel, it emphasizes good sportsmanship and proper golf etiquette.

Membership in the 2009 Treasure Coast Junior Golf Tour is open to all junior golfers, ages 6 to 18 years old and who have completed the annual membership application. All members are subject to suspension and/or cancellation by the committee for violation of any Treasure Coast Junior Golf Tour Rules and Regulations, as provided in this handbook.

Our goal this year is to improve the integrity of the Tour. Included with the tour this year will be a mandatory Rules and Etiquette session that every participant must attend. **YOU and YOUR child must attend the Rules and Etiquette session which has been scheduled at Sandridge Golf Club or your child will not be eligible to play this summer:**

Saturday, June 27 – Rules and Etiquette Session

**9:00 A.M. – 10:00 A.M. (All Ages)**

\*Those juniors who cannot attend must notify Sandridge Golf Club immediately.

\*\*For those juniors that do not have clubs, Sandridge Golf Club will provide them at no extra charge and will distribute them at the Rules and Etiquette sessions.

## Age Group Information

All juniors will be divided into the following age divisions and will play the following amount of holes at each event.

Pee Wee (6 – 8 Year Old)	3 Holes	12 Year Old	9 Holes
9 Year Old	6 Holes	13 Year Old	9 Holes
10 Year Old	9 Holes	14 – 15 Year Old	9 Holes *
11 Year Old	9 Holes	16 – 18 Year Old	9 Holes *

\*Those players that shoot 45 or better in Event #1 in the 14-18 Year Old Age Groups will be eligible to play 18 holes for the rest of the summer. After Event #1, any player who does not break 90 in the 18 hole division two weeks in a row will play 9 holes the rest of the summer.

## Registration Information

Registration for the 2009 Treasure Coast Junior Golf Tour will be **\$80.00**. This fee includes weekly prizes, lunch at each tournament, USGA Rule Book, golf shirt, hat, Rules and Etiquette sessions and the season-ending championship. There will be a \$10.00 discount for a second, third or more child for those families with two or more children on the Junior Tour. I.e. 1st Child – \$80.00, 2nd Child – \$70.00, 3rd Child – \$70.00, etc.

To register your son or daughter, please fill out the entry form and waiver provided with this brochure. Both must be filled out for the child to be eligible to play in this year's events. Due to demand in recent years, TCGA will accept only the first 150 paid applicants.

## Rules For Parents

**All parents must volunteer for at least two events. Please circle on the Registration Form the two dates you can volunteer. Failing to circle the dates will result in an incomplete application. Those parents who cannot volunteer may pay an additional \$30.00 and not have to volunteer. Please include with your child's registration fee.**

- **Parents are not allowed to use a golf cart.** No exceptions.
- Parents may not come within 100 feet of your child age 9 and over. If asked to score for a group, you may NOT score for your child's group.
- The Treasure Coast Junior Golf Tour is not a babysitting service. Prompt delivery and pick-up of your child is expected.

**No Shows:** If a player has entered a tournament and cannot play, it is his/her responsibility to notify the Tournament Committee by calling (772)770-5003. Players that fail to appear without due notice will not be allowed to play in the next event.

## 2009 Rules & Regulations

**Dress Code:** All participants are required to wear their T.C.J.G.T. shirts during all events and **MUST** be tucked in at all times. Juniors will not be permitted to play without their shirts. **NO JEANS, GYM SHORTS OR BICYCLE SHORTS WILL BE TOLERATED.** Shirts must be tucked in. Metal spiked shoes will **NOT** be permitted. Participants **MUST** wear rubber sole shoes or golf shoes with soft spikes. **No exceptions.** Competitors who violate the dress code will be asked to leave the tournament site.

**Golf Cars:** Juniors are not permitted to ride in golf carts, unless authorized by an official. **Parents are not allowed to take a golf cart.**

**Carrying Clubs:** All juniors age 9 and over must carry their own clubs. Juniors are not allowed to take golf bags on greens or tees. Personal Pull Carts will be allowed this year. However, you must abide by the host golf clubs rules regarding pull carts. Pull Carts will not be available by the host clubs.

**Keeping Score:** The USGA Rules of Golf #6-6a states, "After each hole the marker should check the score with the competitor and record it. On completion of the round the marker shall sign the card and hand it to the competitor." Do not just look at the final score. Be sure the score for each hole is correct. If you sign for a score lower than you actually make, you will be disqualified from the event. Check your hole by hole score, not just the final score or how many over par you think you should be!

**Cell Phones:** Cell phones will not be allowed at any host golf course.

**Cheating:** Cheating will not be tolerated and can be avoided if the above procedures are followed. Players should always write down scores at the end of each hole avoiding any later questions about what a player made on a hole. Parents should not get involved with scoring unless so requested by the Tournament Committee. All accusations of cheating should be substantiated by a third party and addressed to an age group leader or tournament committee only.

**Misbehavior:** Misbehavior such as profane language, club throwing, damaging the course or violating Tour Rules will result in disqualification from the event and possible expulsion from the Tour.

**Spectators:** Parents, friends or spectators will not be allowed within 100 feet of the participants over the age of 9 during any of the Tour events; except for those authorized to walk and help keep score with a group. Any communication between parent and child will be considered advice and the parent will be warned once. The second offense will result in a 2-stroke penalty for the child. The third offense will result in disqualification for the event. Unauthorized parents, friends or spectators, on the golf course will be asked to leave.

## Code of Ethics

U.S.G.A. Rules of Golf will govern play at all times. Each year a complimentary copy of the Rules of Golf Book is part of the membership packet. All members are encouraged to familiarize themselves with the rules and carry the Rule book with them at all times.

All players should conduct themselves properly at all times while at tournament sites. Remember, we are guests of the various courses and the Treasure Coast Junior Golf Tour needs these courses more than the courses need the Treasure Coast Junior Golf Tour. Please behave accordingly.

Golf etiquette is a very important consideration, and members are expected to behave in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Treasure Coast Junior Golf Tour. Players must be careful not to damage the course or greens when putting down golf bags, handling the flag stick or with shoes or clubs. Players are responsible for repairing their ball-marks and raking bunkers.

Slow play will not be tolerated. Always be ready to play when it's your turn. Make certain that your group maintains its' position with the group ahead. Penalties for slow play can and will be assessed to the entire group of players causing delays. Players must leave the green as soon as they are done putting.

Players must check in at least a half-hour before their starting time and must be on the tee 10 minutes before their starting time. Introduce yourself to fellow competitors and receive your fellow competitor's official scorecard. Keep your score on the bottom of your fellow competitors card. Place an identifying mark on your ball(s).

## Tournament Sign-Ups

Due to demand and limited course access, you must sign up for each individual event including the Championship by filling out the entry form provided with this brochure. Entries will be limited for each event for each age division and will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Entries **Will NOT** be accepted by way of fax machine or phone.

Once an event has filled up for your age division, a waiting list will be started in the order that the entries were received. Players are responsible for having completed entry forms and fees properly submitted before the stated deadline. All tournaments are stroke play. Play is always conducted in accordance with the USGA Rules of Golf, the Treasure Coast Junior Golf Tour Regulations and the host golf clubs.

## Player of The Year Points

At the conclusion of this year's Tour, awards will be given out to participants based on the number of points they received throughout the summer's events. Points will be awarded in each age division for every event as follows:

1st – 100	5th – 60	9th – 30

3rd – 80	7th – 40	11th – 20
4th – 70	8th – 35	12th – 15
