

2024-25 County Card Information

The 2024-2025 Sandridge County Cards will be sold starting October 1st and will valid from October 1, 2024 to September 30, 2025. Sandridge Card Holders receive a reduced rate for greens fees (as much as \$8.00 in the winter) and eight day advance tee times.

This year in order to be eligible to purchase a Sandridge County Card, you must have one of the following proofs of residency: (1) Valid Florida driver's license with an Indian River County address; (2) Indian River County Registration Card ; or (3) Property Tax Bill/ Receipt. The cost to renew or purchase a Sandridge Card will be \$60.00 plus tax for Indian River County Residents. **Utility bills are not accepted.**

We also offer a Florida Card for \$85.00 plus tax or Florida residents. Florida Card holders will receive the same rate and six day advance reservations. To be eligible to purchase a Florida Card, you must meet one of the three criteria mentioned above with a Florida address.

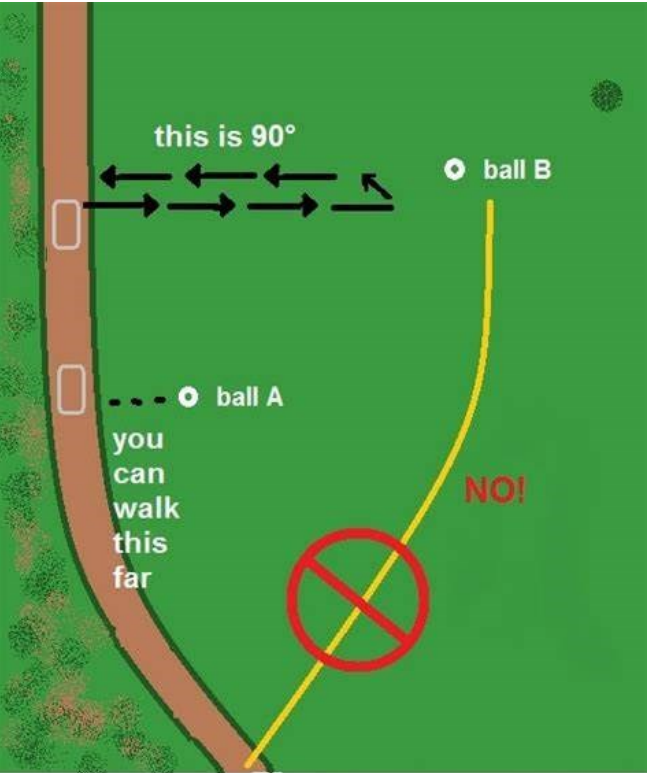
Sandridge Golf Club's Lakes Course Receives #10 Ranking in State

The Lakes Course at Sandridge Golf Club has been chosen as the #10 ranked public course in the state of Florida for 2023. More than 66,000 reviews helped determine Florida's most popular public golf courses according to the Golf Pass' community of reviewers.

They compile their annual Golfer's Choice lists by analyzing the ratings and reviews throughout the previous year. The use GolfPass' ratings Index logic that weights newer reviews and combine it with a course's subcategory average. Courses must offer public access and must have received a number of reviews to be eligible for this year's list. There were 505 Florida golf courses reviewed by the 66,709 players from last year.

Saturday, July 5th  
Sandridge Golf Club – Dunes Course

Format: 4 person Scramble. On every hole, each team member hits a tee shot. The team then selects one of the tee shots from which to play. All members of the team then hit from that position within one club length, no closer to the hole. This procedure is repeated until the ball is holed.

EACH TEAM MUST PLAY 6 HOLES OF THEIR CHOICE FROM THE RED TEES, WHITE, TEES, AND BLUE TEES.

Tee Times: 8:00 A.M. Shotgun Start

Prizes: There will be prizes awarded for the winning teams as well as (4) closest to the pin prizes & men's and ladies long drive prizes.

Entry Fee: \$100.00 per player Includes all golf charges, range balls, tee gifts, prizes & awards luncheon.

No Show Policy

Because of the demand for tee times, beginning October 1, 2024 Sandridge Golf Club instituted a new "No Show" Policy. All guest reserving tee times must enter a valid credit card to reserve any tee times. Nothing is charged to the card at the time of the reservation and all guests must still pay their greens fees and cart fees in the pro shop.

To avoid being charged a no show or short show fee for instance showing up with three players instead of four, you must cancel a minimum of 24 hours prior to your reservation in any one of the three following ways: 1) Cancel 1, 2 or 3 players or the entire reservation online 2) Call the reservation center 24 hours a day at 772-770-5000 ex 1 or 3) Call the Pro Shop during regular business hours at 772-770-5000 ex 2.

The fee charged for the No Show(s) will equal the applicable golf fees for all players that do not get checked in the pro shop.

New Clubhouse Set to Start this Summer

Sandridge Golf Club is moving forward with construction of a new \$11.2 million clubhouse. The County Commission voted unanimously on April 8th to award the construction contract to Quest Contracting, marking a major step forward after more than a year of delays due to high initial bids.

The new 22,000 square foot facility which will include:

- 1) 1,500 square foot Pro Shop
- 2) Full restaurant and bar with a commercial kitchen with 80 seats inside and 50 outside
- 3) 200 person banquet facility with its own Catering Kitchen
- 4) 300 person Event Lawn
- 5) Conference room and offices

The first phase of the project will include expansion of the parking lot which will increase to 205 parking spots. Once complete, construction of the new building will begin with an expected completion date of Fall 2026.

The new clubhouse will significantly enhance the overall experience for golfers and event participants, aligning the facilities with the high standards of the course itself.

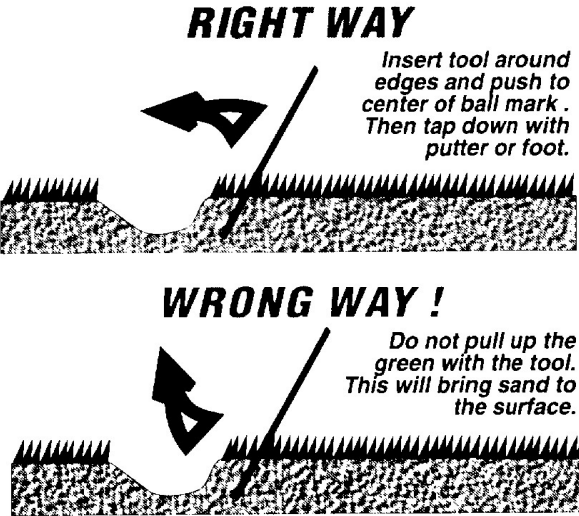
Wednesday Summer League
