

Clubhouse Construction in Full Swing

Sandridge Golf Club began construction of it's new clubhouse in August and walls are going up and the parking lot expansion is in full swing.

The new 22,000 square foot facility which will include:
1) 1,500 square foot Pro Shop
2) Full restaurant and bar with a commercial kitchen with 80 seats inside and 50 outside
3) 200 person banquet facility with its own Catering Kitchen
4) 300 person Event Lawn
5) Conference room and offices

The first phase of the project will include expansion of the parking lot which will increase to 205 parking spots. While the building is ahead of schedule, weather delays have put the site construction of the parking lot behind a number of weeks. We are asking people to carpool over the next month while they finish and pave the new portions of the parking lot and appreciate your patience in this process.

The expected completion date of the clubhouse is in the Fall of 2026. The new clubhouse will significantly enhance the overall experience for golfers and event participants, aligning the facilities with the high standards of the course itself.

2025-26 County Card Information

The 2025-2026 Sandridge County Cards will be sold starting October 1st and will valid from October 1, 2025 to September 30, 2026. Sandridge Card Holders receive a reduced rate for greens fees (as much as \$8.00 in the winter) and eight day advance tee times.

This year in order to be eligible to purchase a Sandridge County Card, you must have one of the following proofs of residency: (1) Valid Florida driver's license with an Indian River County address; (2) Indian River County Registration Card ; or (3) Property Tax Bill/ Receipt. The cost to renew or purchase a Sandridge Card will be \$60.00 plus tax for Indian River County Residents. **Utility bills are not accepted.**

We also offer a Florida Card for \$85.00 plus tax or Florida residents. Florida Card holders will receive the same rate and six day advance reservations. To be eligible to purchase a Florida Card, you must meet one of the three criteria mentioned above with a Florida address.

As in past years, you can renew your County Cards online at www.golfsandridge.com beginning on October 1st. Click on "Buy Online" at the top of the web page This feature will only be for renewals only and not for new County Cards.

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"Dick Bird" Team Championship

"Dick Bird" Team Championship
Saturday & Sunday, November 15- 16

The Treasure Coast "Dick Bird" Team Championship is a 36-hole two-man team competition. The format will be a Modified Pinehurst for the first round and Better Ball of Partners the final round. The field will be flighted after the first round of play. There will be a separate Senior Division for those teams with both players 50 years of age and older. There will also be a separate Mixed Division for teams comprised of one male and one female. Starting times will be assigned for Saturday and all play will begin with an 8:00 A.M. Shotgun Start on Sunday.

Entry Fee: \$300.00 per team. Includes all golf charges, range balls, tee gift, prizes and lunch at the conclusion of Sunday's round.

No Show Policy

Because of the demand for tee times, beginning October 1, 2024 Sandridge Golf Club instituted a new "No Show" Policy. All guest reserving tee times must enter a valid credit card to reserve any tee times. Nothing is charged to the card at the time of the reservation and all guests must still pay their greens fees and cart fees in the pro shop.

To avoid being charged a no show or short show fee for instance showing up with three players instead of four, you must cancel a minimum of 24 hours prior to your reservation in any one of the three following ways: 1) Cancel 1, 2 or 3 players or the entire reservation online 2) Call the reservation center 24 hours a day at 772-770-5000 ex 1 or 3) Call the Pro Shop during regular business hours at 772-770-5000 ex 2.

The fee charged for the No Show(s) will equal the applicable golf fees for all players that do not get checked in the pro shop.
